

FOCUS ON SAFETY Awareness Seminars



The top four causes of construction fatalities are:

- **Falls**
- **Electrocutions**
- **Struck-by**
- **Caught-in**

Known as the “focus four” hazards, these are a top priority for both federal and Cal/OSHA.

Why is supplemental training on these hazards valuable to construction employers and unions? Focus Four hazards account for 79% of fatalities, 85% of all citations, and 90% of dollars in OSHA fines.

Schedule a State Building and Construction Trades Council FOCUS ON SAFETY awareness seminar:

- ▶ Offer open to eligible labor and management groups. Seminars are free of cost to you—our costs are covered by our federal OSHA training grant.
- ▶ Minimum of 15 participants is required.
- ▶ Seminars are ideal for union safety meetings, conferences, apprenticeship classes and gatherings of union and/or employer reps.
- ▶ You choose the option that best fits your group:
 - ✓ 2 *or* 4 hours
 - ✓ English *or* Spanish
 - ✓ We’ll come to your event, worksite or training center
- ▶ Training uses powerpoint and interactive activities to teach about the hazards and how to prevent them. All participants receive English/Spanish factsheets on each hazard.
