FACT: Excavation and trenching are among the most hazardous construction operations.

FACT: Trench collapses cause dozens of fatalities and hundreds of injuries each year.

FACT: It only takes a second for a trench to collapse.

FACT: One cubic yard of soil can weigh as much as a car, an unprotected trench can be an early grave.

FACT: Other potential hazards include falls, falling loads, hazardous atmospheres, and incidents involving mobile equipment.
